
## How to stream RTMPS using JVC GY-HC5x0 camcorders:

1. Check that the camcorder has firmware v0120-0166 or higher from: Menu > System > System Information > Version

- 3. Update the firmware using instructions included in the download package. Confirm the firmware was updated.
- 4. Set the correct Date/Time Setting from:
  - Menu > System > Date/Time. This is a requirement to stream to Facebook.
- Make appropriate network connection using:Menu > Network Connection Setup > Wizard
- 6. Press STATUS button. Press L button to display 9<sup>th</sup> page Connection Setup. Make note of the IP Address
- 7. Press L button to display 8<sup>th</sup> page Network. Make note of the Web Username and Password.
- 8. Open web browser of PC or tablet that is on the same network as the camcorder.
- 9. Type in the IP address of the camcorder. Use the Username and PW noted earlier.
- 10. Open Facebook Account. Retrieve Encoder Settings for Server URL and Stream Key. Select Persistent Stream Key
- 11. From the camcorder webpage, click on Settings icon > Live Streaming > Server1.
- 12. Configure Server1. For example, FB for Alias, RTMPS for Type.
- 13. Enter the URL and Stream Key as one string in the URL field.
- 14. Press Save.
- 15. Press USER3/Online button to start streaming
